

Drills

2015-2016

House Bill No. 4713 requires that each school year the following number of drills shall be run.

Eight (8) fire drills are required. If weather does not permit fire drills to be held at least once a month, then 5 fire drills shall be in the fall and 3 drills held during the remainder of the year with reasonable spacing between them.

Two (2) tornado safety drills are required. At least 1 drill shall be conducted during March.

A minimum of three (3) lock-down drills must be conducted per year. At least one (1) must be conducted by December 1 and at least one (1) after January 1.

At least one (1) drill must be during lunch or recess period or an any other time that a significant number of students are gathered outside the classroom.

By September 15, the chief administrator of a school that operates K-12, or his or her designee, shall provide a list of scheduled drill days for the building to the county emergency management coordinator appointed under section 9 of the emergency management act, 1976 PA 390, MCL 30.409.

Drills must be posted to the web site within thirty (30) school days after the drill is completed and maintained for three (3) years.

Drills must **not** be scheduled to interfere with the state-mandated testing.
